Trauma Recovery Networks (TRNs) Seek Volunteers

The Heartland Kansas TRN and Kansas City, Missouri TRN are seeking volunteers to provide EMDR services in times of crisis.

WHAT IS A TRN?

When disaster strikes, the effect on a community and its members is profound and a variety of responses are needed to address the hardship and suffering. First responders and local organizations deal with the most immediate physical needs of the community. The mental health needs, however, can be neglected and the symptoms can surface weeks and/or months after the event.

A team of EMDR trained Trauma Recovery Network clinicians can work as an integral part of local emergency response. Comprised of local licensed clinicians, at least one EMDR approved consultant, and a TRN coordinator, this team can effectively respond to trauma.

Our two local TRNs are available to respond to the mental health needs of the Kansas City metro area after events such as natural disasters and human-made disasters, and to first responders, etc. Each TRN has a focus of events/populations to which they will respond which are listed in the website below. No one is immune to the effects of community trauma.
